Bunting Takes On A Whole New Look!





To create your own brilliant bunting you will need:

- Suitable patterns and designs to laminate
- 80 micron or 125 micron laminating pouches
- A4 or A3 Laminator

- Scissors
- Hole punch
- Thread/string/ribbon
- Pinking Shears (optional)

Bunting is so very effective and there really is no limit to the designs you can create. Yet you do not have to go to a lot of effort or expense to achieve something really unique.

Whilst looking for inspiration to produce some bunting for the exterior of my garden shed, I suddenly thought of laminating the pendants to provide me with a smart and long-lasting finish. It really was so easy to do and I'm over the moon with the end result.

As you can see I've featured several different vintage designs which I found online. I then cut around each one with pinking shears and popped them into my laminator, using 80 micron laminating pouches (2×80) .

It was then just a case of cutting around the pendants and punching two holes into each one to then thread through the cord. In fact, the hardest thing for me was attaching the cord to the shed. If only I were taller ;-)

As an alternative to looking online for designs you could use patterned paper, card or even thin colourful fabric. Your pendants can also vary in shape; and amongst the superb designs I've come across are triangles, hearts and diamonds.
