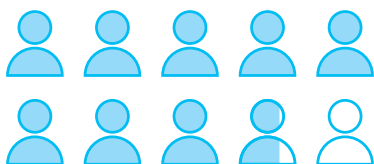

a right for all employees."

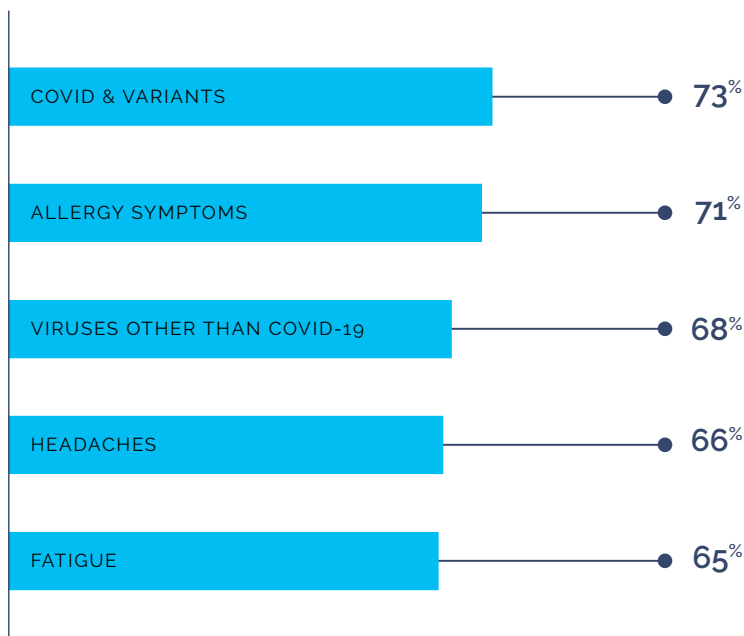


Americans, on average, spend approximately

according to the EPA.

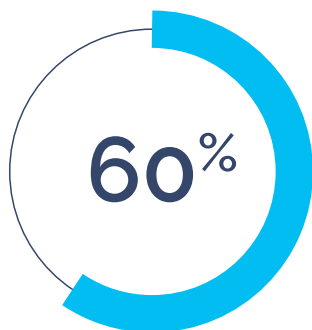


■ 21.5 hours indoors ■ 2.5 hours outside

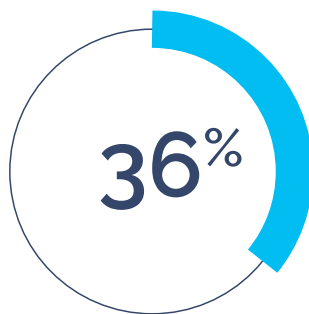
Majority of respondents are at least somewhat concerned
with the consequences of poor indoor air quality at work.



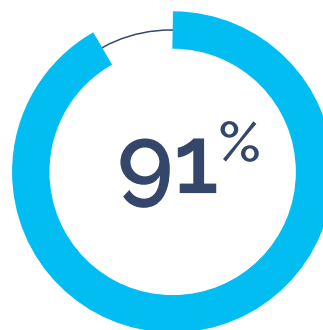
EMPLOYEE PERCEPTIONS OF THEIR WORKPLACE
